Theatre Exchange is a 'youth theatre' for over 60's. We have been devising and touring productions since 2017; bringing entertainment to those who would otherwise not be able to experience it.

Last year 65% of our audience, when asked 'Do you often see live entertainment?' said either "Never" or "Rarely". Our aim is to make our audiences feel good in the dark days of winter. When asked 'How attending the show today make you feel?' last year audiences commented, "Happy, relaxed & feeling good", "It made me feel I should join as well", "Much happier. Worth the long journey"

The group meet weekly throughout the year, improvising, exploring new ideas, seeing shows and creating new work. After last year's production 100% of the participants reported that the process allowed them to build confidence developing skills, and achieve personal goals.
